## What is the Slam Dunk?

A Slam Dunk isn't just any old regular basket in a basketball game. It is the scoring shot that every basketball player, no matter how young or old, dreams of making in front of their friends, team, and the crowd. It's the one basket that makes your team stand up and cheer for you and makes your opponent cringe; it changes the mood and momentum of the game.

Baptism literally means to dip, but this is no ordinary 'dunking'. Baptism is the "Slam Dunk" that makes the devil cringe. Satan knows that he has lost when your momentum changes towards the things of God. Baptism is your public declaration of your personal transformation. I am so proud of each and every one of you who dedicate your life to Jesus Christ and want to take this next step - being baptized. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:18-19 [NIV]

Baptism is a public declaration of a personal transformation.

Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. Romans 6:3-4 [NIV]

- 1. Admit that you are dead in your sins or lost
- 2. Let go, or die, to living life in your own power
- 3. Live your new life with the power that you receive from God
